The QUPEX Golf Classic began in 1965 and proudly maintains its claim as the Australian oil and gas industry's longest running golf tournament!

After 46 years, the tradition continues stronger than ever with 215 players contesting and a record 31 sponsors supporting the event held at the McLeod Country Golf Club on 29-30 July 2010.

The tournament was played in the traditional 2-day format with 65 players in the stroke event and 50 teams in the corporate 3-ball Ambrose event.

On both days, morning fog lifted early, revealing great conditions for golf.
