The Wrap

On 26-27 July 2012, the QUPEX Classic tradition continued with 210 players and 29 sponsors supporting the 48th classic, hosted by McLeod Country Golf Club for the 10th consecutive year.

The tournament was played in the traditional 2-day format beginning with the QUPEX Cup on Thursday. Players revelled in 2 perfect days for golf with the course in great shape after unusual winter rains.

The 3-ball Ambrose was sold-out (as usual) with 153 players on Friday.

Thanks to the generosity of sponsors and players the 2012 QUPEX Classic raised \$12,000 for the Royal Flying Doctor Service, up 20% on 2011.

After many years trying, Peter Lansom finally got his hands on the QUPEX Cup, turning in a sensational 76 net 66, to finish 6 shots clear of Wayne Robins. But Wayne got his share of the spoils the very next day, taking out the coveted Wildcatter Trophy with Ambrose team-mates Steve Armstrong and Rob Dunsmuir.

In the annual grudge match for the Queensland Petroleum Cup, between teams of 4 from QUPEX, SPE, PESA and Roma Oil Patch, SPE with 295 broke an 8-year drought, winning by 1 shot from Roma Oil Patch, and by 3 shots from QUPEX.
